

First G2020 Bachelor's degree ceremony & Panacea party

The annual Bachelor's degree ceremonies will be held on Monday 30 October. This year's ceremonies will be extra special, because this is the first time that G2020 degrees will be conferred.

As large numbers of guests are expected, individual ceremonies will be held throughout the day for each of the Learning Communities. The first ceremony will take place at 11.30 a.m. and the last later in the afternoon (see the appendix for a detailed program for the Learning Communities Molecular Medicine and Global Health).

Each ceremony will take about two hours, and the general programme will be as follows:

- Opening words from the Chair of the Board of Examiners, Dr W. Nieuwland.
- A word from the Dean of Education: Prof. J.C.C. Borleffs.
- A speech by the Dean of the Learning Community.
- You will then receive your diploma. During the ceremony students will be given the opportunity to talk about their experience of the new G2020 curriculum. The Photo Committee of Panacea will capture the moment that you are presented with your diploma.
- Students will be called forward to sign their diploma. In order to organise the logistics in good order we ask you to follow the instruction of the organization.
- After the ceremony there are drinks and snacks in the lobby of building 3219. The Photo Committee of Panacea will be on hand to take photos of you and your parents or fellow graduates.

You may bring a **maximum of three people** to the ceremony. Registration for the ceremony is compulsory (for logistical reasons). You can register from 1 October at Progress WWW (www.progresswww.nl/rug). The deadline for registration is 15 October. The ceremony is only for Bachelor G2020 students who have obtained their diploma before 1 September 2017 (Academic year 2016-2017). **Please bring your student card with you for identification, otherwise the diploma cannot be awarded to you!**

For the students we reserved places. On your chair you can find a sticker with your name on it. Unfortunately it is not possible to sit with the people you invited. For logistic reasons it is not possible to make photos during the plenary part of the program.

Panacea and the Institute of Education are holding a party for all graduates in the evening. The doors open at 11.00 p.m. and the celebrations will go on until the early hours. The theme will be announced on a later date, the location of the party is 'het Platformtheater', Boterdiep 46. So have a bite to eat with your parents, take your degree certificate home and then come and have a drink with your friends to celebrate earning your degree and starting your Master's!
